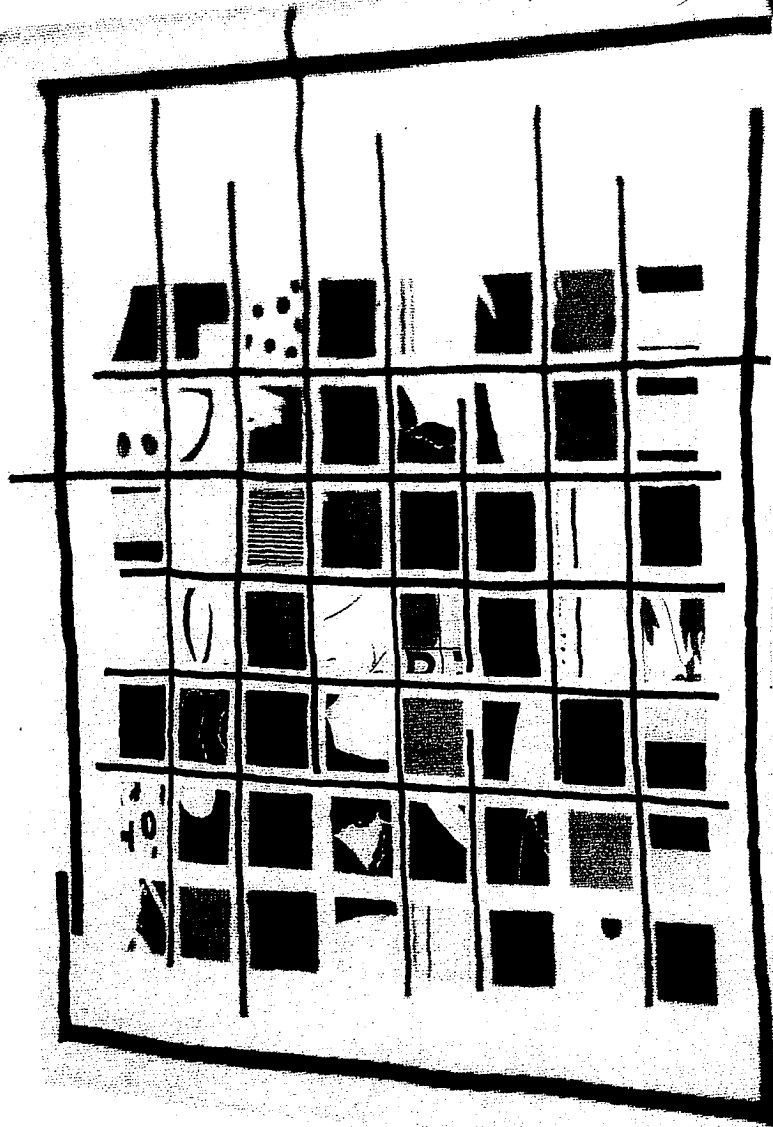

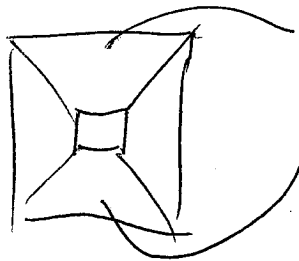

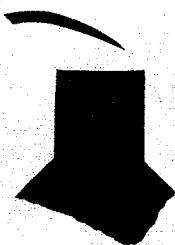
The wildly varied, multicolored 4" (10 cm) square motifs are united by regular black lines of uneven lengths. This is a modern, graphic quilt design.



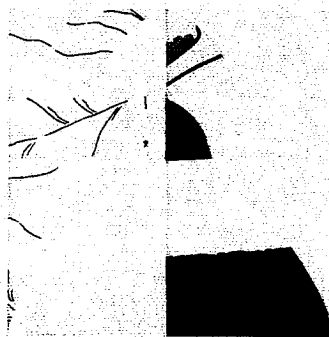

Achieve a simple geometric pattern with just a few contrasting fabrics. Framed in white, the colors of the motif appear vivid and bright.



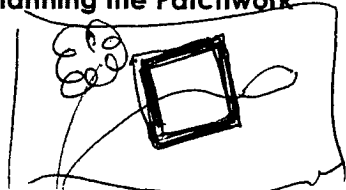
## ■ Framed sampler II

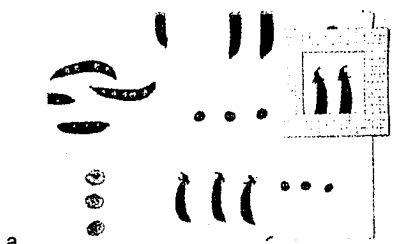

## Planning the Patchwork

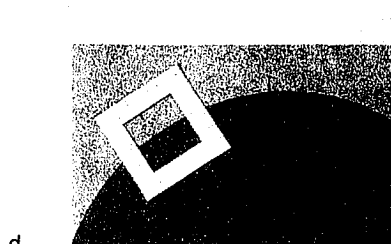


For the patchwork quilting, mix and match cotton and upholstery fabrics with flower designs, polka dots, abstract shapes, and any other patterns, as well as different textured wools and pile fabrics. Experiment with the placement of different fabrics until you find your favorite design.

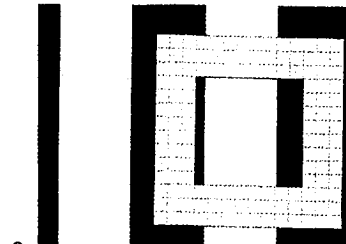

Code Pattern Dimensions

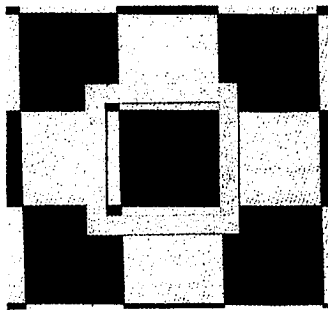


- a Draw the squares to the finished dimensions on thick pattern paper. Add a <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" (1 cm) seam allowance around the outside. Cut out, then cut out the center of the square. The frame is for cutting the fabric, and the center square will be used as a guide for pressing the folded seam allowances. Make 9 patterns for the pieces.

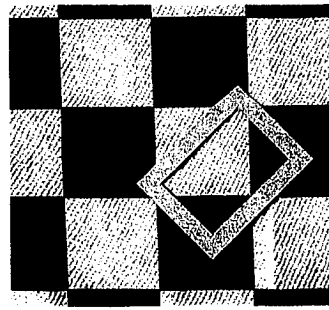

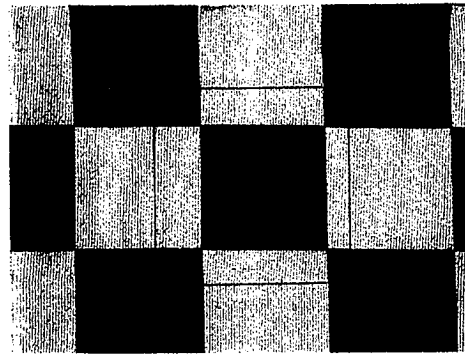
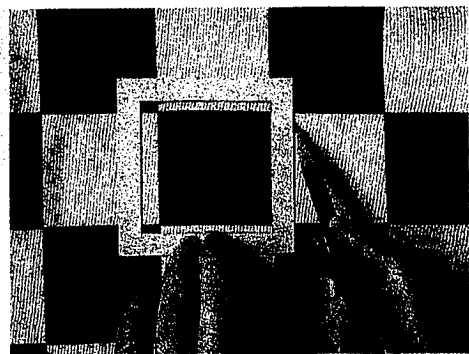
How to Cut O

- b Place the frame on the front side of the checkered pattern so the desired pattern appears within it.



- c Trace a line along the outside of the frame. Cut the fabric along this line. Cut the fabric for the color
